Summary:

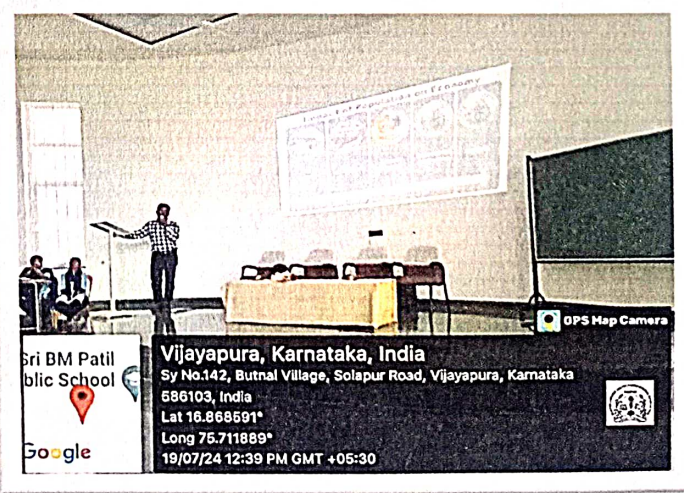

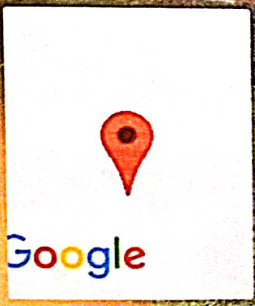
Further, the students realised their own role as the responsible citizens of the country and also as an Economist ways to overcome from the national & global issue of over population.
