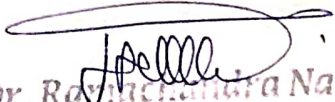

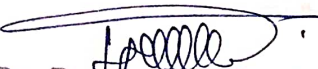

Introduction

- Mobilization of cadets for the event.
- Arrangements for tools, water supply and other necessary resources.

Details of the events (Execution)

On the Occasion of celebration of Independence day on August 15, 2024, SB Arts and KCP Science College association with the A. S. Patil College of Commerce (Autonomous), Vijayapura. NCC Unit, 36 KAR BN NCC organised a plantation drive under the ablest guidance of worthy Principal Dr. R.M. Mirdhe and Dr. B. S. Belagali based on the theme:” **Ek Ped Maa Ke Naam and One cadets one Tree** “on the Occasion of an approach to make mother Earth Planet Green and Clean. NCC cadets were separated all the plastic, bottles and waste materials. Then cleaning the plantation area in the campus

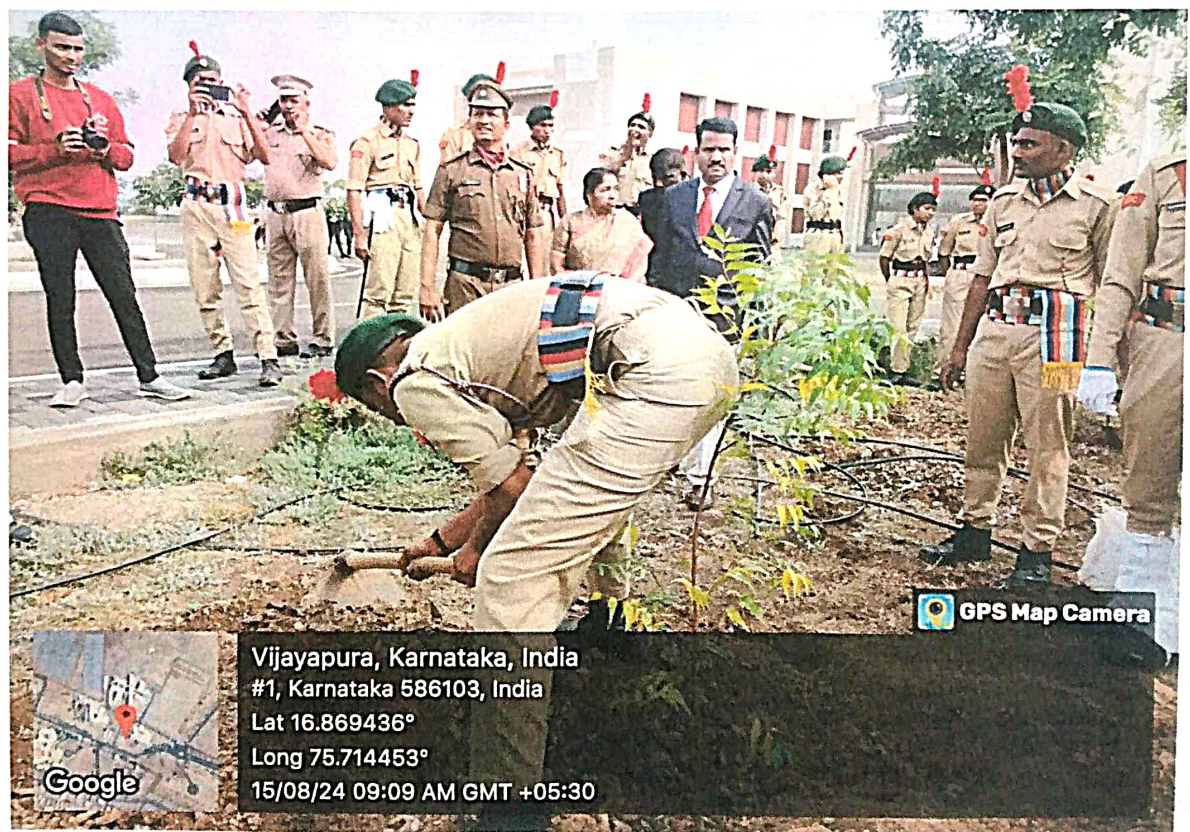
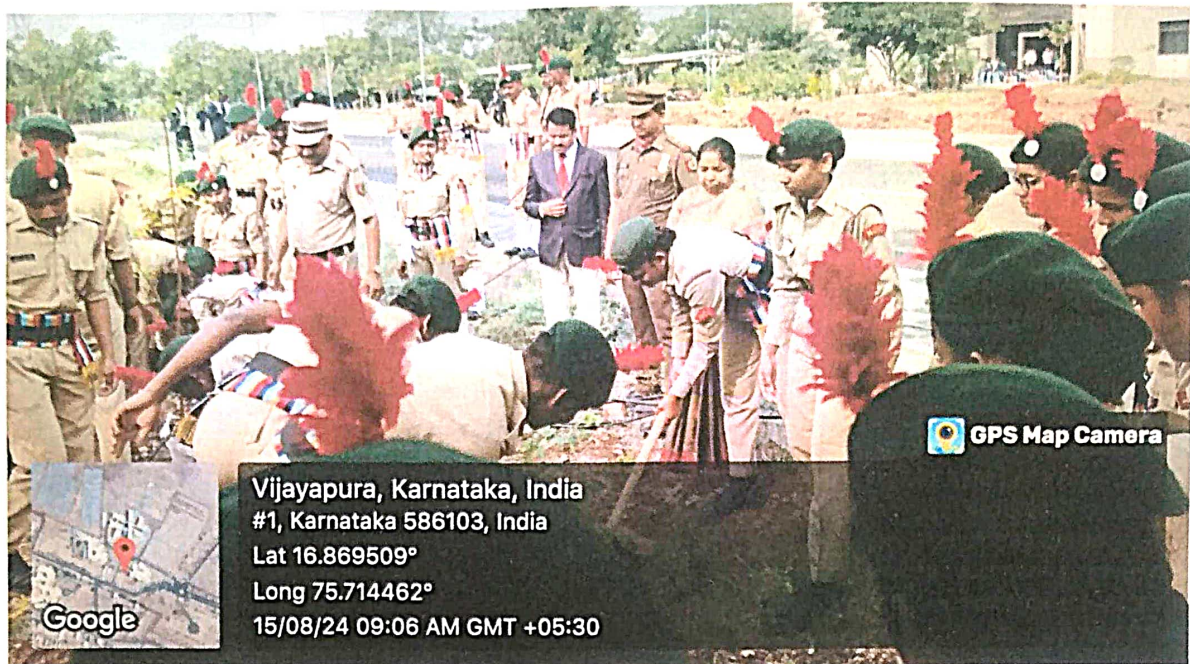

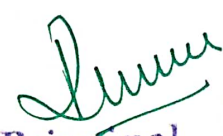
